- Add Keywords/tags as seems appropriate to you, including pediatric if that applies. (While the Categories are a pre-existing list of broad topics, the Keywords/Tags will allow you to add more specific descriptors to your case to aid future users in searching the database.)
- Under “Image 1 (JPG or PNG)” Click the button labeled Choose File. This will open a new dialogue box on your screen which will allow you to select an image from your files to upload. Please make sure that any and all Personally Identifiable Information (PII) is redacted.

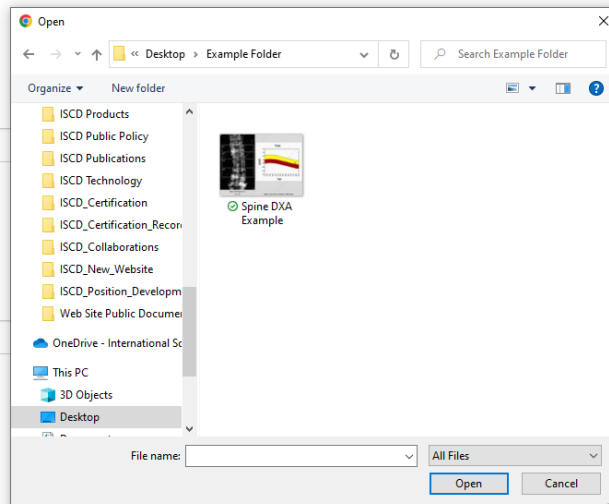
